

**BRAMPTON ADDICTIONS PROGRAM
THE RULES- YOUR DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS
(AFTER PLEA)**

The following are examples of rules you must comply with:

- 1) You are to keep mandated treatment appointment date(s) with service provider;
- 2) You are to keep scheduled court appearance date(s)
- 3) You are to consistently remain drug/alcohol free as evidenced by repeated negative lab results demonstrating you are not using drugs or alcohol;
- 4) You are to lead a law-abiding life and not be re-arrested and/or convicted; and
- 5) You are to comply with all rules and expectations of the program.

If you disobey any of the rules, you may be facing the following penalties:

- 1) You may be admonished in court;
- 2) You may be required to attend additional days for treatment with the service provider;
- 3) You may be required to attend additional in-court appearances;
- 4) Your treatment period may be extended under the BAP;
- 5) Your bail may be cancelled and you may be placed in custody for periods of up to five (5) days, in order to encourage compliance with BAP conditions; and
- 6) You may be expelled from the BAP and sentenced for the offence(s) for which you have pled guilty.

If you complete the program to the satisfaction of the BAP, you may receive a lesser sentence than the Crown originally sought in the case; however, the final sentencing decision, as always, is the decision of the Justice in Court.
